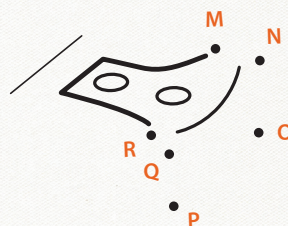
Start at the number 1 and draw a line to number 2. Keep going until the picture is finished.
