What You Heard *In the Word*

- King Josiah decided to seek the Lord at an early age, and he followed God his whole life.
- Josiah got rid of idols and repaired the temple. When the Book of the Law was found, and Josiah heard God's Word, he grieved over the people's sins. Because of Josiah's faithfulness, God promised to wait until after his death to bring punishment on Judah.

OutWord *For Family Discussion*

What if your friend says she thinks she'll go to heaven because her parents are Christians and she goes to church with them? **What could you say?**

That's wonderful that your parents are saved and you attend church together, but YOU have to make the decision to repent of your sins and trust in Jesus. That's not something your parents or anyone else can do for you. The Bible says we're saved by faith in Jesus, not by going to church or obeying our parents. If you understand that your sins separate you from God and you believe that Jesus died to take your punishment for breaking God's laws, you need to pray and tell that to God. When you do, God will make you his child! He promises to never leave you and to give you a home in heaven with him when you die.
