#### **Lesson Focus**

The king of Babylon was hoping to brainwash Daniel and his three young friends. He wanted them to forget their home, their customs, and their God, and serve him. The four young men refused to eat the rich foods sacrificed to idols and instead asked to have only vegetables and water. God blessed their obedience to him and rewarded them with favor, knowledge, and wisdom.




# **Class Notes Answer Key**



- 2. Name one of Daniel's three friends. (Allow several students to answer.) Hananiah, Mishael, Azariah.
- 3. When Daniel and his friends got to Babylon, where were they taken? The king's palace.
- 4. Why were all the smart young men brought to the king's palace? To be trained to serve the king.
- 5. When Daniel and his friends were given new names, what did the king hope they would forget? *Their home country and their God.*
- 6. Is the book of Daniel one of the major or minor prophets? Major.
- 7. What was Daniel's new name: Belteshazzar, Baal, or Shadrach? Belteshazzar.
- 8. What new names were given to Daniel's three friends? Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego.
- **9.** The meanings of the Babylonian names given to Daniel and his friends were about whom? *False Babylonian gods.*
- 10. What does the word defile mean: to make clean, to destroy, or to make unclean? To make unclean.

#### **OutWord** For Family Discussion

Suppose you heard someone say that if a person becomes a Christian, he will have no more sickness, money troubles, or problems, but will have the best life ever. **What could you say?**
