

Review Questions

- 2. What was special about the vessels (cups) that were brought to Belshazzar's feast? They were golden vessels/cups from God's temple.
- 3. What were Belshazzar and his guests doing as they drank from the golden cups: worshipping God, listening to Daniel, or praising false gods? *Praising false gods*.
- **4.** What strange thing happened as the king's guests drank from the golden cups? A human hand appeared and wrote on the wall.
- 5. How did Belshazzar feel as he watched the hand write on the wall? Shocked, alarmed, scared.
- 6. Who told the king the meaning of the handwriting? Daniel.
- 7. How did Belshazzar sin: he was full of pride, he worshipped false gods, or both? Both.
- 8. Who sent the handwriting on the wall? *God.*
- 9. Name one of the three words that were on the wall. Allow several students to answer until all three have been named. Mene, tekel, parsin (peres).
- 10. True or false: Mene meant that God had numbered the days of Belshazzar's kingdom. True.
- 11. True or false: Tekel meant that God had weighed, or judged, Belshazzar. True.
- **12. True or false: Parsin meant that the kingdom would stay together.** *False. It meant that the kingdom would be split up and given to the Medes and Persians.*
- 13. What happened on the same night that Daniel read the handwriting on the wall? The king was killed.
- 14. Who became king after Belshazzar was killed: David, Darius, or Damon? Darius.
- **15. What law was King Darius tricked into signing?** A law that people could pray only to the king.
- **16.** What did Daniel continue to do even though he knew about the law? Pray three times a day to God.
- 17. How did Darius punish Daniel, even though he didn't want to? Threw him in the lions' den.
- 18. What did God's angel do to protect Daniel in the lions' den: shut the lions' mouths, opened the den, or killed the lions? Shut the lions' mouths.
- 19. How did Darius feel when he learned that God had saved Daniel? He was very glad.
- 20. When Darius saw that Daniel's God had saved him, he made a law that all people in his kingdom must fear the Lord, obey Daniel, or pay more taxes? Fear the Lord.



What You Heard In the Word

OutWord For Family Discussion

Suppose your friend said that she prays for things every day, but she doesn't always get what she asks for. **What could you say?**

That's great that you're praying every day. God wants us to come to him with requests, especially when we're in need of help, but he wants our prayers to be more than that. How would your parents feel if you only came to them asking for stuff or for help with an emergency? What if you didn't talk to them about anything else or ever say thank you for all they've already done? That wouldn't be a good relationship. The Bible says that prayer should be part of our relationship to God and should include giving praise and thanks. We have the joy of talking to God as our heavenly Father. We should thank him for all the blessings he's given us and the prayers he's answered. Because he is the all-powerful Creator, we should praise him for his amazing qualities, like his mercy, love, and wisdom. And just like with our parents, we must remember that sometimes an answer is no or not now because God knows what's best for us, and we can thank him for that, too.
