What You Heard In the Word

- The first death recorded in Scripture is the animal that God used to clothe Adam and Eve after they sinned. This pointed to the future sacrifice Jesus would make once for all sinners.
- The blood of Jesus provides the forgiveness of sins for those who repent and believe in Him.

OutWord For Family Discussion

You have a friend who believes Genesis 3 about Adam and Eve—but she also believes that evolution is true and that fossils are millions of years old. What would you say to her?

I don't believe that evolution can be true. Fossils are formed from dead animals. We know from the Bible that Adam and Eve committed the first sin in the garden about 6,000 years ago. Well, when God killed the animal to make clothes for Adam and Eve, it was the very first death ever in the whole world. So, there couldn't have been animals dying out millions of years before then. Basically, if you believe in evolution, then you're saying the Bible is not true.
